Answer the question:

What can you do to improve your watershed?

- * Independently, or as a team of no more than four, identify an environmental concern that impacts your watershed.
- * **Come up with a solution to address the concern.** Discuss your idea with your parents, teachers, friends and local experts.
- * Research your idea and **explain it in an approximately 1,000 word proposal.** Include visuals (videos, models, graphics etc). **Be creative!**
- * Proposal guidelines can be found at **CaringForOurWatersheds.com**
- * Entries are judged on **innovation, environmental impact, comprehensive scope, communication, budget, realistic solution and visuals.**
- * Go to **CaringForOurWatersheds.com** and register your team. If you do not have web access, contact your local Program Coordinator for a paper registration form. Entries must be delivered by mail or submitted online no later than the **contest deadline: March 18, 2011**
- * **Finalists will be selected to make a five minute verbal presentation** to a panel of judges and a public audience. Finalists' entries may be displayed in your community.
- * **All students are encouraged to implement their ideas.**
- * **You can win rewards for yourself and your school!**
