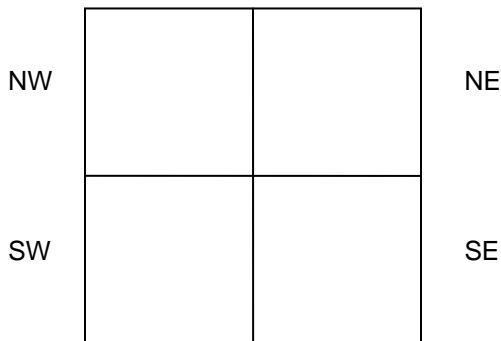

**GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

- Projects applied for must be within the WSRCD; and
- Failure of a landowner to meet Landowner Responsibilities may negate him / her from other WSRCD programs.

**PROGRAM DETAILS AND ELIGIBILITY**

- Conservation District must be involved from start of project.
- Landowner must follow grazing and fencing recommendations.
- Landowner only eligible for assistance every three years.
- Deadline for application is June 1.
- Conservation District will provide free GIS planning with the development of pasture system.

**LANDOWNER RESPONSIBILITY**

- Provide access for inspection, survey and construction.
- Adopt a rotational grazing practice as suggested by the conservation district.
- Not alter, change, remove or modify the project without written consent of the District.
- Indemnify and save harmless the District from any and all actions, claims, suits, damages, injuries or other loss no matter howsoever arising as a result of the construction, operation or maintenance of the project.
- Will not sell, trade or barter materials purchased by the district.
- In case of new ownership or rental change, the district ask that they be notified and be able to approach new landowner/renter to continue the project or return part of the cost of the fencing materials.
- Landowners will also determine the appropriate number of livestock to their pasture=s carrying capacity.

**CONSERVATION DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY**

- Determine application priorities in consultation with the Sub-District and Board staff.
- Reserve the right to reasonable access to project areas for tours or to inspect the conditions of the project site.
- Develop project in consultation with specialist from Manitoba Agriculture.
- Provide 80% assistance toward the cost of materials for the development of a fencing system to a maximum of \$1000.
