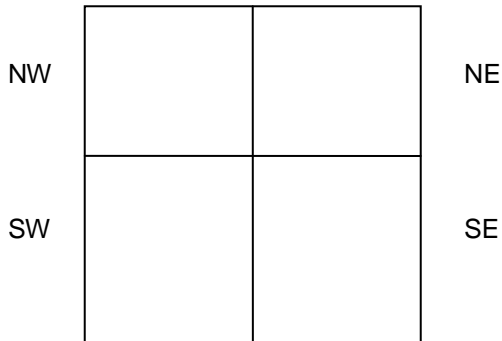

- **Area must be properly prepared prior to planting, this means the area has to be summerfallowed for a season or approved by Conservation District Staff prior to day of planting. If a suitable planting site does not exist, the WSRCD will not plant the shelterbelt.**

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- Projects applied for must be within the WSRCD; and
- Failure of a landowner to meet Landowner Responsibilities may negate him / her from other WSRCD programs.

LANDOWNER RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide access for planting, weed control & inspection.
- **Area must be properly prepared prior to planting, this means the area has to be summerfallowed for a season or approved by Conservation District Staff prior to day of planting. If a suitable planting site does not exist, the WSRCD will not plant the shelterbelt.**
- Supply additional weed control as necessary.
- Maintain planting for a period of 10 years.
- Protect plantings from livestock by fencing, chemical, insect or fire damage.
- Place marker stakes supplied by West Souris River Conservation District to mark planting site location.
- To establish grass between rows and mow between rows.
- Provide watering if necessary
- Check with Rural Municipality regarding set back distance from road allowance when planting adjacent to road allowances.

BOARD RESPONSIBILITIES:

- The Board has the right to refuse any application due to an unsuitable site location or distance from main buildings. WSRCD follows PRFA guidelines for distance set back from buildings: 100ft.
- Provide mechanical maintenance services in the second and third year for new shelterbelt planting.
- Provide replanting services in the second and third year after planting if there is only 50% -80% tree survival.
